



The Youth Empowerment and Policy Project (YEPP) is looking for youth specialists between the ages of 14 and 18 who are interested in learning about advocacy and policy while working on bringing awareness to their communities on the dangers of underage drinking.

The Youth Specialist is a paid, per diem position that meets on a monthly basis. Persons interested must be willing to learn public speaking skills, advocacy skills, and be able to work independently.

YEPP's primary goal is to change factors in the social, legal, economic and political environment that encourage, enable or support underage drinking. An underlying philosophy of the project asserts that, because underage drinking is a problem affecting the youth population, the most effective way to analyze and improve the environment is to directly involve youth in the discussion.
